

Activity Ideas: As a teacher you will have many ideas - these are just to help you get started:

1. Have a grandparents day and invite a grandparent to visit the class.
2. Have a baby day and ask parents to bring their baby. Point out the different ages to show continuity of development.
3. Have students share pictures of their little brothers and sisters. Show different stages of development.
4. Visit a convalescent home and adopt a grandparent.
5. Have a pregnant mother, baby, child, teen, parent, grandparent visit the class to show how growth is planned by our Creator.
6. Have a capable person with a handicap share his/her disability with the class.
7. Have students try riding a wheel chair, using crutches, walking blindfolded etc. to better understand those with various challenges.
8. Visit a hospital or invite a doctor or nurse to class to share life-saving techniques and first aid. Discuss the importance of each and every life.
9. Have the children see a sonogram of a developing baby and hear the heart beat.
10. Visit a cemetery to see the ages of people and how long ago they lived and maybe something written on the tombstone.
11. Pass out a fetal model to the students and discuss fetal development and the miracle of life from the beginning.
12. Place posters on the wall showing the development of the child in the womb for discussion.

Consider ordering or downloading a Pro-Life Lesson Plan for grade the student is in. There are an average of 10 lesson plans for each grade.
