

# CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PETITION TO THE KANSAS HOUSE AND SENATE

On April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019, the Kansas Supreme Court **created a nearly unlimited “right” to abortion in the 1959 Kansas Constitution and continued to allow the live dismemberment of unborn children in our state.** Kansans have lost the right to ban even the most horrific practices like partial-birth and taxpayer-funded abortions. Countless mothers and their preborn babies are at risk.

***Therefore, we urge you to sign the following petition*** calling for the Kansas Legislature to pass an amendment to the Kansas Constitution that reverses the Court’s ruling and declares there is no unlimited “right” to abortion in our state. If approved by the legislature, the Amendment will be subject to a public vote at a scheduled election.

**We, the undersigned, urge our Kansas Representatives and Senators to vote for a constitutional amendment.** The amendment would reverse the *Hodes v. Schmidt* decision and state that there is no “right” to unlimited abortion in the Kansas Constitution. Our tax dollars should not be used for abortion. The public, through our elected officials, must have a voice in these matters and our rights should not be stripped away by the courts.
