

Kansans for Life Summer Intern

Location:

KFL has offices in Overland Park, Topeka, and Wichita, but interns may do much of their work from home if they live elsewhere in the state. Interns will need to have the ability to travel to meetings and to locations where work needs to be done. Efforts will be made to assign interns to the local community events / door-to-door campaigns nearest to where they live but some driving will be required for everyone.

Qualifications:

Available to work for at least eight weeks during the summer.

Strong passion for the protection of innocent human life. Desire to use the summer as a learning experience in nonprofit operations, issue advocacy, educational programs surrounding a public issue, and/or grassroots political action.

Excellent verbal, written and interpersonal communication skills.

Attention to detail.

Ability to multi-task and flexibility / willingness to change tasks depending upon the most urgent needs of the organization.

A willingness to travel and work nights and weekends, especially during the height of campaign season. Campaign environments can be stressful; applicant should perform effectively despite stressful conditions.

Ability to work well with others.

High School Diploma. Graduating high school seniors and current college students may apply.

Responsibilities:

Depending on their interests and skills, interns may:

- organize outreach events
- organize fund-raisers
- staff KFL information tables at various public events and fairs
- utilize their skills in writing, web design, graphic design, social media, and/or photography to produce pro-life content
- answer questions from the public about right-to-life issues and current campaigns
- serve as clerical and research staff for the PAC (Political Action Committee)
- walk door-to-door with petitions, pro-life literature, and/or pro-life voter guides
- be involved in PAC-related grassroots mobilization in priority electoral contests throughout Kansas
- contact and coordinate KFL's volunteers for projects and events
- perform other duties and tasks as assigned.

Compensation:

Interns will be paid \$250 per week, plus 40 cents per mile for required travel.
